
(1) Basic Approach

JICA has been working mainly on bi-lateral cooperation program/project since 1954. Regional cooperation frameworks which include nature/forest conservation activities have been active in many area (Asia, Amazon, Africa etc.). ALOS2 has scan SAR (L-band) sensor which can detect forest change under cloud.


Deforestation (illegal logging) is a still big issue and needs from Tropical Countries including Brazil are huge.



(JICA-JAXA Forest Early Warning System in the Tropics)


