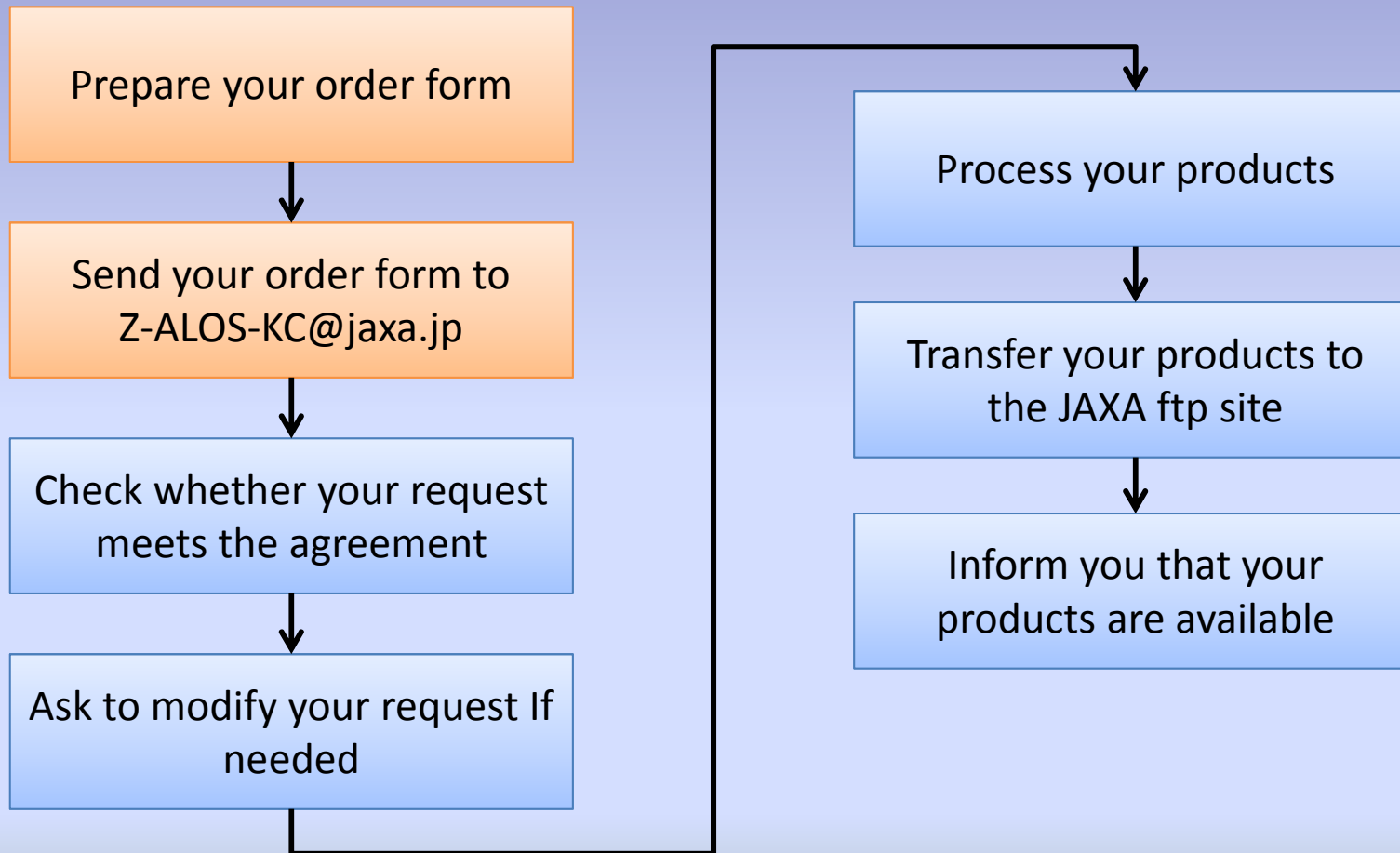
Mosaic and Path Products

- Path products
 - Observation modes: ALOS/PALSAR FBS, FBD, ScanSAR
 - Pixel Spacing: 25m
- Mosaic products
 - ALOS/PALSAR
 - FBD mosaics
 - Pixel Spacing: 25m
 - Image size of one tile: 1 deg. X 1 deg.
 - ScanSAR mosaics (per cycle)
 - Pixel Spacing: 100m
 - Image size of one tile: 1 deg. X 1 deg.
 - JAXA has prepared the ScanSAR mosaics for the following regions
 - » Africa : 2007-2010 (cycle 9 to cycle 39)
 - » South America: 2007-2010 (cycle 9 to cycle 39)
 - » Southeast Asia: 2009 (cycle 24 to cycle 32)
