

Guideline for Presentation at SAFE Workshop

In the SAFE Workshop, SAFE prototype applicants present their proposal to a Review Board for recommendations and approval. The Review Board evaluates proposals in the evaluation points (in the Review sheet: next page). Furthermore, the presentation of the proposal should be done to the evaluation committee within 15-30 minutes highlighting the below <u>a to e</u> key points: specifically main items in "SAFE Prototype Application Form".

- a. Purpose of the Prototype (**Project Purpose**)
- **b.** Expected Outputs of the Prototype (**Outputs**)
- **c.** Work Plan of the Prototype Activity (**Activities**)
- d. Expected Benefits of the Prototype (Overall Goal)
- e. Roadmap after Completion of the prototype (Vision of Operational Use)
